

METRO PHOTO ID PROGRAM

For \$2.00, seniors and persons with disabilities may obtain a Metro Photo Identification Card, which entitles the holder to reduced bus fares.

To obtain the Photo Identification Card, the following criteria must be met:

SENIORS

Must be age 62 and over. Bring proof of age: drivers license, medicare card, passport or other to any Metro Discount Photo ID Session.

DISABLED

Must bring a completed Metro Certification Form, or a Medicare card to any Metro Discount Photo ID Session. Metro Certification Forms must be completed by a medical practitioner or other party verifying that a rider has a disability. Certificate Forms may be picked up at Metro Center Information Booth or requested by phone, 425-8600, TDD 425-8993.

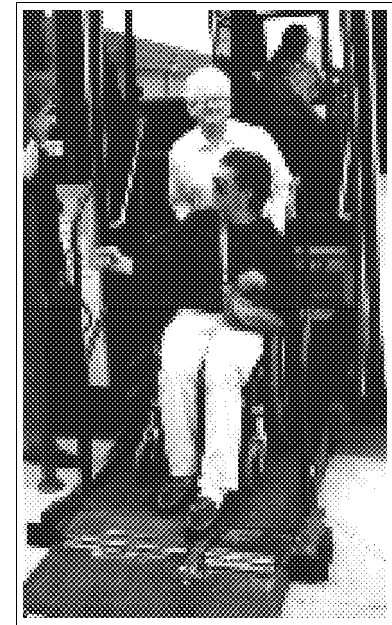

MOBILITY TRAINING

Mobility Training provides free instruction to seniors and people with disabilities who want to ride Metro buses.*

Mobility Training is offered on a one-to-one basis and follows these steps:

- A personal meeting with the mobility trainer to discuss the program.
- Planning a training schedule tailored to individual needs.
- Training on board Metro buses. Three or four rides are usually all it takes.

Mobility Training teaches people how to:

- Ride the bus safely
- Obtain a Photo ID Card
- Purchase discount tickets
- Make connections between buses
- Handle unexpected situations
- Read the HEADWAYS bus schedule

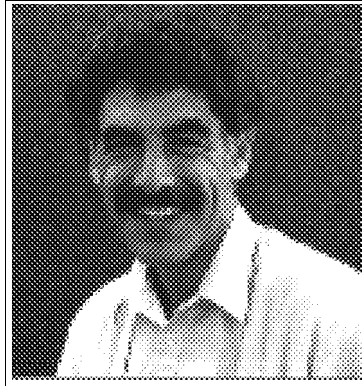

Boarding-Deboarding Training

If needed, training is offered on how to use passenger lifts, kneeling buses and other special services.

* Eligibility for mobility training is based on criteria established by the Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District. Training in progress may be curtailed at the discretion of the Mobility Trainer.
