

DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES DRIVER LICENSE REPORT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE

As part of its employment application process, the Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District (SCMTD) requires a Driver License Report, which can be obtained from the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). This report provides the driving record history, which is required by the SCMTD, for positions requiring a Class C Driver License. However, this report also contains information, which the SCMTD does not use for hiring purposes including, but not limited to, physical and mental restrictions, legal history, and participation in DMV surveys.

Before providing the Driver License Report to the SCMTD you may score through or black out the information listed above or any information not required for hiring purposes.

I, _____, understand that some of the information contained in the DMV Driver License Report is not required by SCMTD to determine eligibility for hire and I have been given the opportunity to score through or black out that information. If I have not scored through or blackened out this information, I waive my right to do so. I also understand that the only relevant information to determine eligibility for the position to which I am applying from the report will be my driving record.
